Handwriting is Fun Camp!

Are you concerned about your child's current level of handwriting? Is poor legibility or handwriting speed affecting their grades? Let us help! HIF Camp is run by our OT staff who assess each child to determine pencil grip, current writing level, hand strength, and coordination. Handwriting skills are improved through both fine and gross motor play, & utilizing games & activities to make learning FUN for each camper. Correct letter formation, baseline orientation, & size of writing will be taught to improve legibility.

Sports and Outdoors Camp

Join us for a fun week of practicing running, kicking, throwing, balancing and jumping as we play outdoor games and practice sports skills with a variety of balls, hoops, balance challenges and obstacle courses. Activities during camp will include skilled intervention to improve body awareness, running skills, throwing/catching, balancing, kicking, receiving endurance, community integration and strength. Campers need to have independent mobility, assistive devices welcome, be able to participate in small groups, communicate needs and be independent in toileting.

Kids in the Kitchen Camp

KITK camp is designed to help children become more independent in the kitchen & enable them to be a part of daily family meal routines. Campers will learn safety awareness & typical kitchen rules while being introduced to simple cooking tasks. Safety awareness in the kitchen allows children to begin to explore participation in meaningful daily routines such as making lunches & helping to cook meals. Learning these skills gives children a sense of pride & independence, & can enrich family bonding & time spent together working towards a goal. KITK Camp is targeted at children ages 8-14 who are able to follow directions & communicate effectively with others.

Social Skills Camp

The We Thinkers! series helps children build fundamental social competencies and improve their social and academic performance. Our social skills camp teaches children five core concepts that strengthen their perspective taking and social self-awareness appropriate for their age and ability. Play is the learning environment of young children, and the curriculum uses play to teach social competencies in fun and engaging ways! The evidence-based concepts supported across the components of learning about thoughts and feelings, thinking with your eyes, following the group plan, keeping your body in the group, and whole body listening, establishes a common social vocabulary for children that are foundational to all social interactions. In order to participate, children must be potty-trained, able to verbally communicate and have awareness of peers in their environment.

Art Camp

Through exploration of famous artists and art work, children will tap into their creativity and see the world through a new lens. While discovering impressionism through Monet or abstract work through Kandinsky, children will interact with various tools to create their own versions of famous work. While interacting with different medium, techniques, and utensils, students will develop their fine motor skills to support life activities and handwriting and to promote overall hand/finger functioning. Students will explore how art can relate to movement and how colors/images can relate to emotions. This fun, creative and explorative group will teach children through vision, movement, and touch to have a full body experience of art. Children participating in this camp should be able to follow verbal directives and sustain attention during group work.

Performing Arts Camp

Have your child join us for Performing Arts Camp this summer! Led by a licensed Speech-Language Pathologist, the camp will focus on story comprehension, social, and speaking skills. Each day the campers will learn about a new Aesop fable. The main elements of the fable will be discussed, acting and character development will be targeted, as well as basic theatre technique and etiquette to set the stage for the performance of one of the fables on the final day of camp! This camp is targeted at children ages 5-8 and 9-12 who are able to follow multiple step directions and communicate their needs to others.
